To raise funds for the **Jann Rutherford Memorial Award**, **Sandy Evans** is creating a unique improvised music event. Sandy will perform a 6 hour improvisation (from 2.00pm to 8.00pm). Musicians of all levels, instruments, ages and styles are invited to join Sandy for twenty-minute spots to raise funds. Our goal is to raise \$15,000 for the 2016 Award. JRMA was founded in 2005 to assist in the professional development of an outstanding young female jazz musician. The Award is named in honour of the late jazz pianist Jann Rutherford and is funded by private donations in partnership with Melbourne International Women's Jazz Festival, Sydney Improvised Music Association and ABC Radio National. The

winner of the award receives assistance with performances for her band, recording for ABC Radio National and publicity and promotional materials. JRMA also runs a mentorship scheme to support female high school jazz musicians.
